Welcome to ThunderDome, where novices enter, veterans leave.

Discover the new ThunderDome Divorce Clinic—an arena where you can learn the ins and outs of the divorce process from experienced family law attorneys in a controlled, supportive environment. When you register, you will be paired with a client to handle a simple divorce case from start to finish. To help the attorney through representation, a two-hour session will be held approximately once a month. Each session will provide training relevant to the stages of a divorce case. The second hour of each session will include time to ask questions and talk about your case in a group setting as well as listen to the questions and problems of other participants. In addition to the monthly sessions, all participants will be able to call Statewide Legal Services with any questions or problems they encounter along the way. Help a low-income client receive the representation that they deserve and sharpen your practice skills!

Participant Requirements:

- An attorney licensed in Connecticut.
- Must commit to handling a simple divorce case through to the end—approximately 6 months.
- Enjoy working and learning in a group setting.
- Attend clinic sessions on each of the following dates:

October 25	Motions Before Judgment and Discovery (5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.)
November 14	Agreements and Preparation of Judgment (5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.)
December 12	Final Hearing (5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.)
